Pastor's Column/Carta del Párroco

Following last Sunday's image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd, on this 5th Sunday of Easter, we are invited to reflect on our sense of belonging and connection to Jesus, as the True Vine, and we as his branches. In today's Gospel (Jn 15:1-8), Jesus uses this symbol to illustrate the deep relationship between himself and his disciples. Just as branches draw nourishment and life from the vine, we, as members of the Church, draw our spiritual sustenance from our connection to Jesus.

In our first reading, we hear about Saul (Paul), whose encounter with God's love and mercy on the road to Damascus transformed him from a persecutor of the Church to one of its most fervent apostles. His conversion story reminds us that no one is beyond the reach of God's love and that through our encounter with Jesus, we are incorporated into the community of believers. Jesus' branches outreach far beyond what we can even imagine!

Our second reading (1 Jn 3:18-24) challenges us not only to profess our love for God and neighbor but to demonstrate it through our actions. These actions are the fruits that we, as Jesus' branches, produce as we remain in his Spirit. Love is not merely a sentiment but a call to compassionate deeds, rooted in the truth of our belonging to God's family.

As branches connected to the vine, we find our identity and purpose in Jesus Christ. Through our encounters with his love and mercy, we are grafted into the body of believers, becoming part of the Church, the people of God. This sense of belonging extends beyond mere membership; it is a deep, abiding connection that shapes our lives and relationships.

In a world marked by division and isolation, the message of belonging and connection in today's readings is profoundly countercultural. It reminds us that we are not meant to journey alone but to be united with one another in Christ. Our faith is not a solitary pursuit but a communal endeavor, where we support and encourage one another on the path of discipleship.

As we reflect on the readings, may we renew our commitment to remain connected to Jesus, the true vine, and to one another as branches. May the love of God strengthen our bonds of fellowship and empower us to love God and neighbor in both word and deed, bearing witness to the truth of our belonging to the family of God.

Continuando la imagen del domingo pasado de Jesús como el Buen Pastor, en este quinto domingo de Pascua, estamos invitados a reflexionar sobre nuestro sentido de pertenencia y conexión con Jesús, como la Vid Verdadera, y nosotros como sus ramas. En el Evangelio de hoy (Jn 15:1-8), Jesús utiliza este símbolo para ilustrar la profunda relación entre él y sus discípulos. Así como las ramas reciben nutrición y vida de la vid, nosotros, como miembros de la Iglesia, obtenemos nuestro sustento espiritual de nuestra conexión con Jesús.

En nuestra primera lectura, escuchamos sobre Saulo (Pablo), cuyo encuentro con el amor y la misericordia de Dios en el camino a Damasco lo transformó de perseguidor de la Iglesia a uno de sus apóstoles más fervientes. Su historia de conversión nos recuerda que nadie está fuera del alcance del amor de Dios y que a través de nuestro encuentro con Jesús, somos incorporados a la comunidad de creyentes. ¡Las ramas de Jesús se extienden mucho más allá de lo que podemos imaginar!

Nuestra segunda lectura (1 Jn 3:18-24) nos desafía no solo a profesar nuestro amor por Dios y el prójimo, sino a demostrarlo a través de nuestras acciones. Estas acciones son los frutos que nosotros, como ramas de Jesús, producimos mientras permanecemos en su Espíritu. El amor no es simplemente un sentimiento, sino un llamado a acciones compasivas, arraigadas en la verdad de nuestra pertenencia a la familia de Dios.

Como ramas conectadas a la vid, encontramos nuestra identidad y propósito en Jesucristo. A través de nuestros encuentros con su amor y misericordia, somos injertados en el cuerpo de creyentes, convirtiéndonos en parte de la Iglesia, el pueblo de Dios. Este sentido de pertenencia se extiende más allá de la mera membresía; es una conexión profunda y duradera que moldea nuestras vidas y relaciones. En un mundo marcado por la división y el aislamiento, el mensaje de pertenencia y conexión en las lecturas de hoy es profundamente contracultural. Nos recuerda que no estamos destinados a viajar solos, sino a estar unidos unos con otros en Cristo. Nuestra fe no es una búsqueda solitaria, sino un esfuerzo comunitario, donde nos apoyamos y nos animamos mutuamente en el camino del discipulado.

Mientras reflexionamos sobre las lecturas, renovemos nuestro compromiso de permanecer conectados a Jesús, la vid verdadera, y a los demás como ramas. Que el amor de Dios fortalezca nuestros lazos de fraternidad y nos enseñe a amar a Dios y al prójimo, dando testimonio de nuestra pertenencia a la familia de Dios.

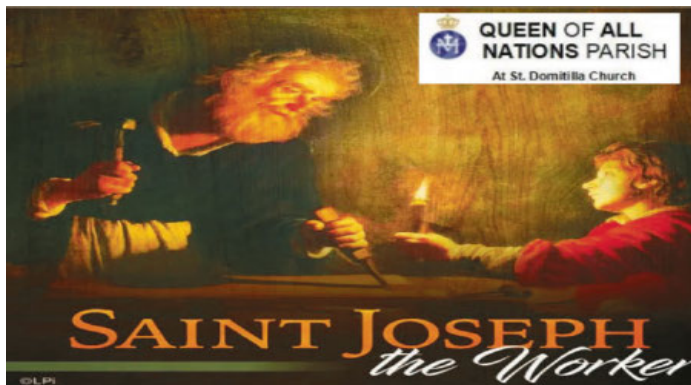

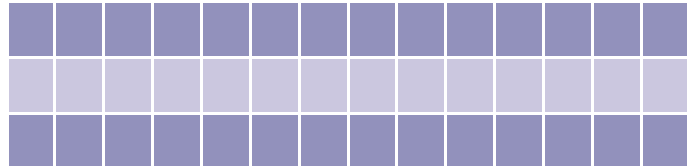

Printing on bricks will be in Uppercase & Lowercase letters.

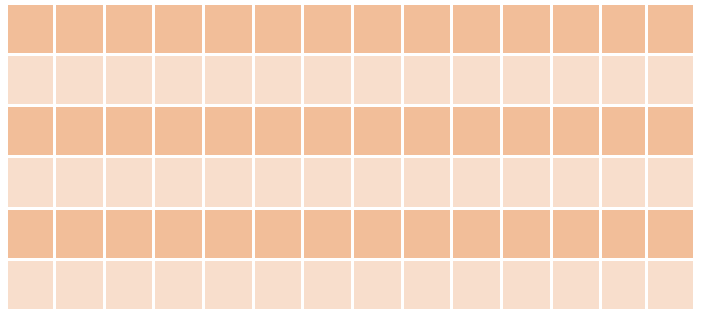

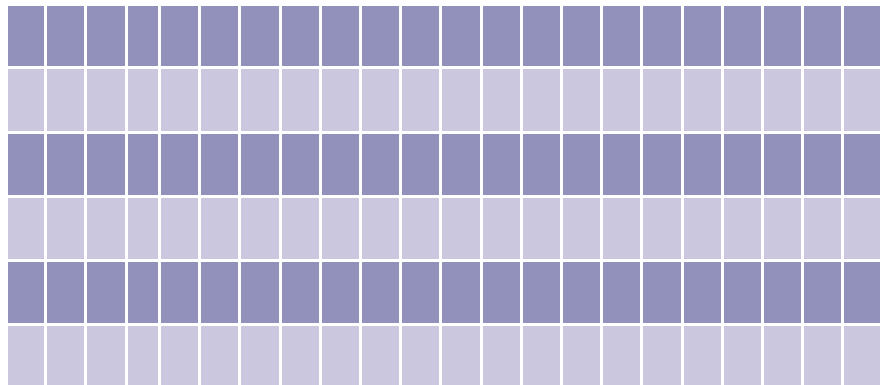
